

UNDERTAKING FOR THE BRAINS ONSITE SIMULATED EXAMINATIONS

I, _____, _____ years old, and an applicant for the BRAINS Onsite Simulated Examination for the Chemistry Boards, accept the following terms and conditions of my admission to the exam and the test day instructions included herein and, *upon my honor*, vow to comply with them.

1. I agree that the examination process and content are fully confidential and that I will *not reveal nor describe nor discuss them to anyone by any manner*. Content here is defined as examination instructions, question topics, question types and levels of analysis, levels of difficulty, questions and answer choices, and similar information.
2. I agree to maintain the integrity of the exam proceedings, content, and results. I will abide by all the Test-Day Rules a copy of which forms part of this undertaking.
3. I agree that I shall not make records nor recording of the examination and its processes, by any means, whether analog or electronic, by writing, or taking pictures, videos, or sounds, by myself or with others.
4. I know that the exam I am applying for does not contain the same materials as the actual examinations and do not expect it to do so. No such representation has been made of any leaks of the actual examination via the exam simulation and, if any similarity is found between the simulation and the actual examination, the same cannot be attributed to BRAINS.
5. All BRAINS communications with me shall be made through the cellphone number and email address I registered upon enrollment for the exam.

I understand that these agreements and my honoring them shall form contractual obligations the breach of which may be brought for action with the concerned government agencies.

TEST DAY INSTRUCTIONS

On Test Day

Please be at the exam venue at 7AM (Ang Bahay ng Alumni, Magsaysay Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City. Bring only the following:

- 2 pcs #2 or HB pencils, sharpened
- Black-ink ballpen
- Calculator allowed by PRC from most recent list
- 1 clean eraser (we recommend Staedtler white eraser)
- Snacks and Lunch (non-smelly, "quiet" snacks)
- Bottled water
- School ID
- A wristwatch

- The valid ID you used in the registration.
- A duplicate print-out of your actual NOA with the Application Number erased or redacted
- A long, brown envelope
- A transparent plastic envelope

No cellphones will be allowed during the exam. Cellphones shall be placed in quiet mode and kept in the student's bag, which will be placed in the front of the room, at all times.

What to do:

1. Eat and do your comfort room rituals before taking the exam.
2. Take your medications, if any, before taking the exam.
3. Have your valid ID ready.
4. Go through the identity verification process.
5. Read all test instructions and rules thoroughly and follow them strictly.
6. Read the exam questions carefully but be aware of your time still available. The proctor will write on the board the time left for you to finish the test section, starting at the last 5 minutes.

Prohibited Activities

1. Attempting to take the test for someone else or having someone else take the test for you at any stage of the examination.
2. Coaching of answers or attempting to receive assistance from another person—communication in any form is not permitted during the online session.
3. Reading aloud the test items or your computations.
4. Editing, copying, taking pictures, including scans, or attempting to edit/copy/duplicate any test content from the testing website.
5. Reproducing or disclosing the test content or any part of the test content by any means (e.g., hard copy, verbally, electronically) to any person or entity.
6. Writing on or otherwise mutilating or marking the exam question materials. We will provide scratch paper for you to use. Fine for making/or causing marks on the exam booklet or any of its pages – P150.
7. Leaving the test space or room during the test.
8. Harassing or threatening your proctor in any form or manner.

Note: You will not be allowed to take a restroom break, but you may eat or drink during the exam. Your answer sheet is checked by scanner. Ensure that your exam materials and answer sheets stay dry, with no stray marks.

When asked to go to the comfort room before the start of the test, please do so. If your bladder is small or you have to urinate frequently, a useful tip is to wear an adult diaper.

Prohibited Materials

Using or having any of the following materials in the testing **room** is prohibited. Please clear your room and table or test space of these items before the test session.

1. Phones (mobile, landline, wired or wireless)
2. Tablets and e-readers
3. All wearable technology, except a plain wristwatch

4. Any other electronic, recording, listening, scanning, printing or photographic devices, whether analog, digital, or human
5. Pagers or beepers or any other legacy or current communication equipment
6. Pens, highlighter pens, compasses, rulers, protractors
7. Mirrors (of any kind)
8. Books, pamphlets, notes, regardless of content; dictionaries, translators
9. Unauthorized materials for scratch work
10. Scan pens or scanning devices

You may not possess nor use these materials during the examination, including the test break.

If you are caught violating any of these rules, you will be disqualified from continuing with the test and your score shall not be released.

No-Show and Noncompletion of the Test

If you are absent on the day of the exam, you forfeit the deposit paid. In all cases, you will need to pay the exam fee if you wish to take the test on another date, only if another date is available. No retakes of the same test are allowed, free or paid.
